Board met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Members present Merle Doty (via phone), Diana Dawley and Jason Roudabush.

Chairman Dawley led the pledge of allegiance.

Moved by Roudabush, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dawley to approve agenda. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

8:30 a.m. Ashley Fallis, General Assistance met with board for quarterly meeting.

9:00 a.m. Russ Behrens, Grinnell City Manager; Dan Agnew, City of Grinnell Mayor; Dan Sicard, Grinnell Fire Chief met with board to provide update on establishing a City of Grinnell Municipal EMS system to serve the Grinnell community that provides high quality Advanced Life Support (ALS) service levels for 911 calls. They are planning to have this operational by January 31, 2025.

9:15 a.m. Lyle Brehm, Engineer joined the meeting.

Brehm presented the plans for bridge replacement on V18 north of the high school in Brooklyn. Moved by Roudabush, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Doty to approve bridge replacement plans. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Brehm also presented the FY'23 Iowa Department of Transportation budget and the county 5-year program setting forth road and bridge projects proposed for completion over the next 5 years. Moved by Doty, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Roudabush to approve the FY'23 IDOT budget and county 5-year plan. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

Dawley discussed photos of the brush cutting being completed in rural road ditches. Dawley has received several complaints about the mess that was left from the shredding. Brehm would like to bring in the road superintendent to meet with the board to discuss their concerns and look at options on how they could do things differently.

9:25 a.m. Tom Kriegel, Sheriff joined the meeting.

Kriegel stated he had a 28E Agreement with Central Iowa Regional Tactical Team that required board signature and he also has an individual he would like to hire as part-time dispatcher/jailer. These items were not on the agenda for today's meeting so they will be added for approval at the meeting on Monday.
